

You will need:



Bowls for icing - cereal bowls work great, if you have a large group split the icing into smaller bowls once mixed.



Water - a small measuring jug or even milk jug will do!



Tools - I have provided some piping bags for those that want to go pro, but a teaspoon each will work just as well too!



Icing sugar - I have provided enough for you, but it is always handy to have a back up bag in case you add too much water.

How to mix the icing:



Empty the bags of icing sugar into separate bowls. Each bag contains a different coloured powder, so don't mix them all in together!



Add a few drops of water and start to mix with a spoon - gently, or it will fly everywhere!



Keep adding water, but just a few drops at a time until you reach a consistency somewhere between toothpaste and shampoo!



Keep stirring until all lumps have gone!
